History of The Hume Center's Services in Contra Costa County

Hume Center initially began as Neurobehavioral and Psychological Institute (NPI) in 1993, offering psychotherapy and psychological evaluations out of a single room at a local graduate school. The agency renamed itself as The Hume Center and developed a broader continuum of care by achieving Community Mental Health Center status and opening a Partial Hospitalization Program in 1994. In 2001, the agency expanded out to East County by opening an office in Pittsburg. In 2013 we expanded our services in Pittsburg to include Psychiatry and Case Management as we opened our first Full Service Partnership (FSP) program. In 2016, we proudly opened our Richmond office as we added two new programs: FSP services were expanded to serve West County and we started a new Outpatient Program.

Contra Costa Behavioral Health Services

Hume Center offers three levels of care in Contra Costa: Outpatient Services, Partial Hospitalization, and Community Support. Psychiatric symptoms commonly treated include anxiety, depression, mania, trauma, psychosis, suicidal thoughts, co-occurring substance abuse, and others.

Outpatient Services

Individual Psychotherapy: aims to create a safe place where the work you do each week will enhance your life, inspire new awareness, and develop adaptive skills.

Couples Psychotherapy: offers a contained space to work on your relationship together, seeking to build a relationship that enhances both of you.

Family Psychotherapy: Families are systems and sometimes the whole system needs to work together to find new ways to relate to each other.

Group Psychotherapy: allows you to understand each others' challenges and learn from them in a supportive group environment.

Case Management: helps you connect to community resources, attain appropriate housing, and learn skills and find opportunities to support your recovery and become more independent.

Concord and Pittsburg

Contra Costa Outpatient Services (CCOP) provides weekly psychotherapy to adults, adolescents, and children facing moderate psychiatric disabilities in our Concord and Pittsburg offices.

This program accepts Medicare, Medi/Medi, and private payment on a sliding fee scale. Private insurance and Medicare Advantage accepted with prior authorization.

Richmond

Community Integrated Outpatient Services (CIOS) provides psychotherapy and case management to adults of all ages facing moderate to severe

psychiatric disabilities. Services are provided in our Richmond clinic and in the community.

This program accepts Medi-Cal insurance. Authorization by Contra Costa Mental Health required.

Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP)

PHP assists adults with severe acute psychiatric disabilities by providing intensive therapeutic services five days a week from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at our Concord Clinic. Participants are evaluated by a treatment team to create an individual treatment plan that includes group and individual psychotherapy, psychoeducation, and psychiatric services.

The program aims to help participants:

- Reduce symptoms and relapse
- Prevent hospitalization
- Stabilize by reintegrating into the community
- Recover in a supportive environment

Program Details:

- Transportation to and from parts of Contra Costa County are provided to those who qualify and are based on need
- Breakfast and lunch are provided.
- Twice-monthly visits with our psychiatric provider are provided while in the program
- Program graduates are usually eligible for Aftercare services to help maintain stability.

This program accepts Medicare, Medi/Medi and private payment on a sliding fee scale. Private insurance and Medicare Advantage accepted with prior authorization.

Community Support Program (CSP)

Pittsburg and Richmond

Our Community Support Programs in East and West County provide intensive and comprehensive community-based psychosocial rehabilitation services for adults (aged 26 and above) with chronic and severe psychiatric disabilities. The program operates as a continuous treatment service to provide evidence-based, recovery-oriented services to assist individuals to:

- Prevent repeat hospitalizations
- Transition from institutional settings
- Attain or maintain medication compliance
- Improve community tenure and quality of life
- Attain or maintain housing stability
- Attain self-sufficiency through vocational and educational support

Services Offered:

- Comprehensive Case Management
- Psychiatry (Pittsburg only)
- Individual, Family, and Group Psychotherapy
- Integrated Dual Diagnosis Treatment
- Housing, Vocation, and Education Support
- Peer-Support Services
- Family Support and Psychoeducation
- 24/7 Crisis Support
- Social Skills Training
- Direct navigation of community supports

This program accepts Medi-Cal and uninsured Contra Costa residents. Authorization by Contra Costa Mental Health required.

CSP has been funded by the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) in partnership with Contra Costa Mental Health.
